



Foreword

Welcome to our first ALI brochure covering the educational opportunities in aviation in Ireland today. This is a first step in addressing the ALI mandate to "develop new and existing educational and skills initiatives" and "attracting and retaining talent in the industry".



The intention is to highlight the rich diversity of courses open to people in Ireland in pursuit of a career in aviation and also to identify areas where training might be developed in support of the leasing industry. We want to encourage the institutions providing training by publicising their work more widely and also encouraging them to develop training courses in a more integrated national framework.

We have identified the Undergraduate and post graduate courses that we believe exist today in Ireland and have worked with the institutions to illustrate the numbers that have been through the courses in the last few years. In a later publication, we will expand to include Vocational training in technical fields, including apprenticeships, as well as continued education to broaden skills and adapt to the changes happening in the business.




